

Honey Grove City Wide Clean up **Scheduled April 21st – April 28th**

The City of Honey Grove City Wide Cleanup will begin on Saturday April 21, 2018 and end on Saturday April 28, 2018. Citizens **inside the city limits** may begin placing debris and “junk” items on the curbside on **Friday April 20th**. **DO NOT PLACE OUT BEFORE THIS DATE.** For curbside pickup, you **MUST** call to put your name on the list at City Hall. If you fail to comply with this request, you could cause the City to not pick up your trash and you will be responsible for hauling your own, no matter what the circumstance. Please don't block your poly cart to allow the trash service to collect household garbage. For the citizen's convenience, there will be open top containers, **For Honey Grove Water Customers ONLY**, to haul their own trash and junk from Saturday April 21st until Saturday April 28th. The City urges anyone that has pickups, trailers or someone that is able to haul their own junk, to please do so. Due to Budget cuts, the man power for the City is minimal. Sanitation Solutions will be delivering a roll-off to the Vacant Lot located between South 5th and South 6th Streets on Commerce, on Friday April 20th.

NOTE: If you currently have junk or brush at your curbside, you can call City Hall for a pickup, but you will be charged a minimum of \$45.00, depending on the size of the load. The junk and brush cannot be placed out this early, and you are responsible to clean this up immediately. This is a health hazard and if it is not cleared, you can be fined.

The City has requested that all citizens that want junk picked up **MUST** separate all brush from junk, or the pile will **NOT** be picked up. We are asking that you comply with this request. The City takes brush to a separate location and this will simplify the pick up. Tires, batteries, chemical and fertilizer products and containers, concrete, dead animals, any appliance with Freon and paint will not be picked up or accepted on site. The City of Honey Grove asks that all Citizens, Groups and Organizations interested in cleaning our City to please participate in keeping “Honey Grove Beautiful”. City wide participation depends on the annual clean-up continuing for Honey Grove. Please contact Linda, Cindi or Jaci at City Hall at 903-378-2323 or 903-378-3033, to have your name placed on the list for pick-up, **ONLY** if you are unable or you have no means to haul your own trash.

If the weather does hinder the scheduled city clean-up, the City would appreciate it if those of you that are able, haul the items you have placed by your property to the Containers located between 5th and 6th Street on Commerce Street. Rain will cause water to stand and it is a breeding place for mosquitoes and snakes. We urge everyone to make an extra effort to haul your own items and to help us clean up Honey Grove.
